



REQUEST FOR MANHATTAN TRANSPORTATION OPTION
SEPTEMBER 2023 through JUNE 2024

The Office of Pupil Transportation (OPT) presently offers yellow bus service to students that reside in the same borough as their school. For this reason, Manhattan Christian Academy can only accommodate bus service for students who live in Manhattan. Moreover, this service is for children in Kindergarten through the second grade who live over 1/2 mile from the school and for children in grades 3 through 6 who live one or more miles from the school. It is not a door-to-door service, but the bus stops are near several students' homes. The OPT requires a minimum number of students per bus route, and the route cannot be longer than 5 miles.

Please choose one stop, and whether your child will use morning, afternoon, or both services.
